We will also be completing a mini Geography Topic about the 4 countries of the UK.

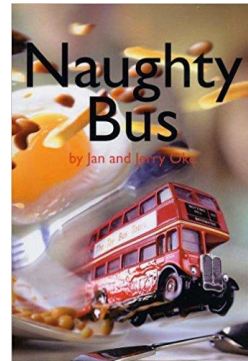
P.E.
