**Book:** Fantastic Mr Fox by Roald Dahl

**Non-Fiction:** Our non-fiction this term will be focused on writing a non-chronological report on foxes.

We will also be focusing on persuasive texts arguing from the view point of Mr Fox.

## Maths

The start of the term will be focused around money. This will include identifying the different coins, adding and subtracting and finding how many different ways we can make amounts.

We will then be moving on to shape and direction. The key language within this will be around properties of shape such as vertices and faces, lines of symmetry and when looking at direction we will be discussing turning clockwise and anticlockwise in different quarter segments.

## Reading

Our reading will be looking at books based around animals including traditional tales and adverts to aim their persuasive writing. We ask that you read as many texts as possible with your child.

## Art/DT

We are looking at LS Lowry and focusing on size and perspective. We will also be exploring colours.

## Topic

**PSHE:** We are looking at being healthy, being relaxed and healthy eating. This includes looking at different types of exercise, using different strategies to create mindfulness and what food to eat to achieve a healthy diet.

**Geography:** The focus is on countries, seas, capital cities within England and human and physical features.

**Music:** The theme for the term is 'Zootime'. This will focus on instruments and the children will learn the lyrics to their focus song and to play the beat on Glockenspiels.
