

English

Poetry: We will be looking at a range of vocabulary and technical language, playing with the way we use words and rhythm.

Book: How to be a super hero by Rachel Yu

Non-Fiction: We are going to be writing instructions. The focus will be on using the correct language and ordering accurately. New vocabulary will be focused on as well as a range of punctuation.

Maths
