Topic

PSHE: We are looking at celebrating differences which entails boys and girls, bullying, standing up for myself and making new friends.

R.E: We are focusing on Jesus, Saints and advent. This will include practice for our Christmas performance.

History: This term we are investigating real life heroes to fit with our Heroes topic this term. Our focus will be Florence Nightingale and Mary Seacole to fit with our topic in English. We will also look at Ghandi, Neil Armstrong and the RNLI.

Maths

We are starting the term by looking at standard units of measurement. These include meters and centimeters.

Then we will be moving on to graphs. These will include pictograms, bar charts and tally charts.

The end of the term will be focused on multiplying and dividing by 2, 5 and 10.

Reading

Children take full responsibility for changing their reading books. They are given time before school and after lunch to choose a different book if they have finished their previous one.

Art/DT

We will be looking at natural sculptures. This will include observational drawings, clay work and a 'big build'. We are hoping to display the children's work in a Year 2 open gallery.

Homework

Homework will be given on a Friday and due back on a Wednesday.

Each week the children will be provided with spellings. The focus is going to continue to be on the Year 2 common exception words. These are a key focus for the year and it is essential the children can write these confidently.

There will be additional tasks including Maths, English and Topic. Tasks are created to allow children to master the skills and for those having difficulty to develop their learning. Reading should be consistently done throughout the week.
