Book: The true story of the three little pigs – Jon Scieszka

Fiction: We are going to be writing a newspaper report looking at the events of the story from different perspectives.

Book: Where my wellies take me – Clare and Michael Morpurgo

Fiction: We will be writing a 5-part story focusing on the plot, with special emphasis on the importance of the ending. There will also be poetry intertwined with this.

Maths

We are going to be recapping key concepts to ensure knowledge is sound.

This will be focused on place value, adding, subtracting, multiplying, dividing, fractions, money, time and scales. We will also be looking in depth at scales and how to read them correctly and measure accurately.

A key focus is developing their fluency with times tables and counting backwards and forwards from any given number.

We have looked at 2, 3, 5 and 10 times tables.

Science

We are continuing to look at habitats as our topic is where my wellies take me.

This term we will be completing practical science and investigations.

Topic

Overall: The topic 'where my wellies take me' will be enriched through a range of outdoor excursions as well as creating letters/diary entries/post cards.

PSHE: We will be completing lessons based upon knowing how to make friends, solving friendship problems, helping others to feel part of a group, showing respect, helping themselves and others when feeling upset or hurt and what makes a good relationship.

Geography: Our key focus is using fieldwork and observational skills to study the geography of the school and other local areas.
