Book: Fire Cat - Philip Hurst

Non-Fiction: Our non-fiction this term will be focused on writing instructions. We will be looking at fire safety and what to do in the event of a fire.

Fiction: Our fiction will be based around the Great Fire of London. We will be writing a diary entry discussing the events that happened and describing the setting through story writing. A key focus will be on using a range of descriptive language to discuss how the events happening would affect your senses.

Maths

This term we are looking at time to five minute intervals. This includes o'clock, half past, quarter past and quarter to.

We will then be moving on to fractions and looking at quarters and halves. This will also include division and looking at the direct relationship between the two.

After that we will be looking at adding and subtracting through regrouping. We will be using the column method for this as well as using a range of resources.

Science

Our Science is focused on feeding and exercise. We will be exploring the vocabulary omnivore, herbivore and carnivore and looking at the effects of diet and exercise.

Reading

Our reading will be looking at books based around fires, searching tales and information texts around animals as well as baking. We ask that you read as many texts as possible with your child.

Art/DT

Our focus is looking at cityscapes and landscapes. We will be using paint and pastels to recreate famous images by artists such as Monet and Van Gough.

Topic

Music: The theme for the term is 'I wanna play in a band'. This will focus on instruments and the children will learn the lyrics to their focus song and to play the beat on Glockenspiels.
