In English our focus text is 'Rooftoppers' by Katherine Rundell. This is a story about a young girl who is found floating on a cello case when the ship she is travelling on sinks. Sophie is insistent that her mother is still alive which leads Sophie to embark on a trip to Paris. Whilst there, Sophie meets Matteo, a French rooftopper. They set forth on an adventure across the rooftops of Paris...

### Fiction

### Science

### Term 4

### Maths
