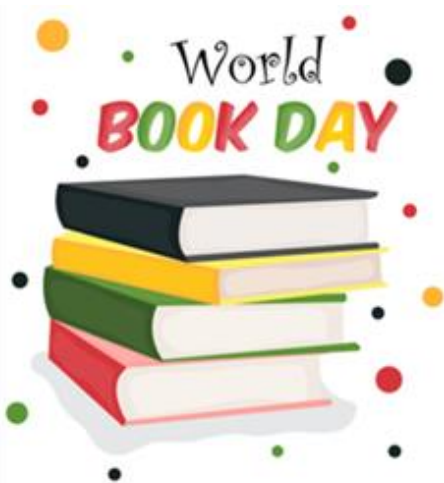

World Book Day, Friday 2nd March

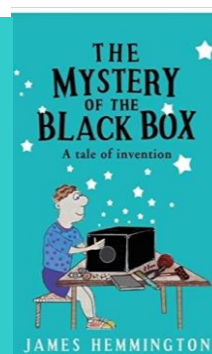

Information from the School Health Team

The School Health Service is launching a new model of health assessment, called the Lancaster Model, which will support schools to target health interventions based on the specific, identified health and wellbeing needs of their students.

The team would have contact with children and families at four key stages: Reception, year 6, mid-teens (year 9/10) and post 16-years-old to complete a health and development review. This will enable the service to identify needs so early intervention can be offered, preventing any problems from developing further.

Health and development reviews assess health, risk and protective factors, family health, emotional health and wellbeing, lifestyle choices and behaviour.
