## **Rocking Ridgers and Breakfast Clubs (Covid-19 arrangements)**

This year, to accommodate as many pupils as we can safely, we will be running two clubs in the morning and in the afternoon.

Our first club will accommodate Reception to Year 3 and will be held in the lower hall. Your entrance and exit for drop off and pick up will be Hare Way.

Our second club will be for Year 4 to 6 will be held in our upper hall and again your exit and entrance will be Hare Way.

We must advise you that both clubs will be running at full capacity and so we may not be able to accommodate additional times and dates. Places must be booked by Friday lunchtime of the week prior to need. Payment needs to be made at the time of booking your child's place. If the account falls into arrears your bookings will drop off the system and your child will be unable to attend the club on that day.

Due to Government guidelines there will be other changes to the running of these clubs. For all clubs, parents will not be allowed into the hall and collection will be from the door only. Additionally, please do not allow your child to bring in items from home to play with during club times.

### **Breakfast Club:**

- Breakfast Club will now start at 8:00 to allow for enhanced cleaning procedures
- The cost is £2.50 which includes breakfast
- Breakfast will be provided but limitations have been placed on what can be offered
- Pupils will be escorted to their classes at their relevant start times

### **Afterschool Club:**

- Afterschool Club will finish at 5:30 again to allow for enhanced cleaning
- The first session will finish at 4:15 with a cost of £3.50
- The second session will run until 5:30 and will also cost £3.50 (£7 for the two sessions)
- A snack will be provided
- There will be limited play facilities as we will adhere to current guidelines
- Where possible play will take place outside so please ensure your child has suitable clothing
