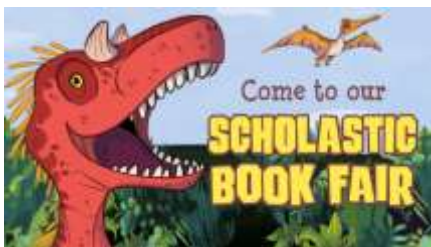




Y3 Visit Hastings Museum
