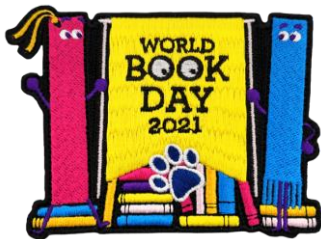




Children returning to School: Monday 8th March
