- not going through private court proceedings Group.

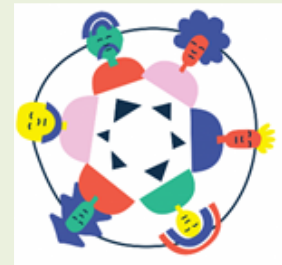
