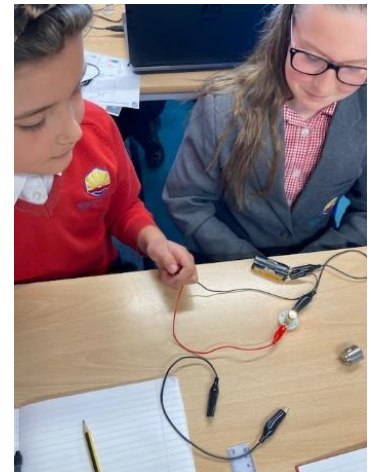
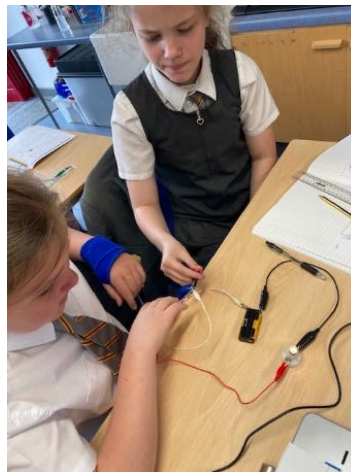
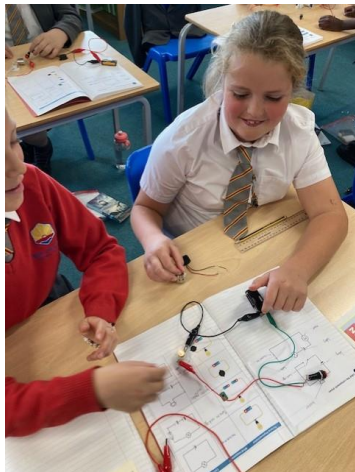

## Parent/Teacher Consultations

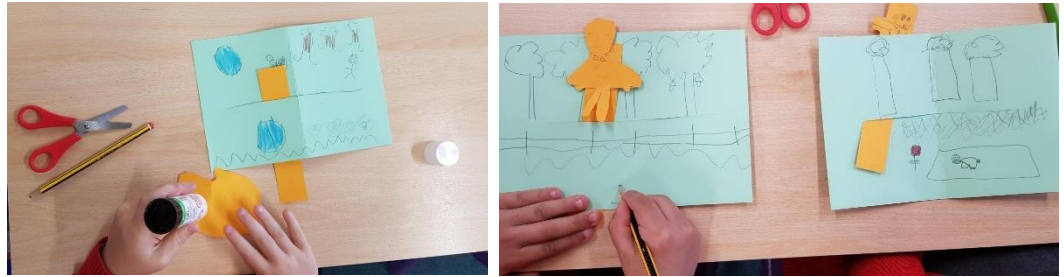
